
User info for Bellus sofas

We congratulate you on your new Bellus sofa.


The purpose of this manual is to give you information about the use and care of the sofa, as well as the general guarantee info. Please read the instructions carefully before using the sofa. Manufacturer will not take responsibility for any damage that occurs from incorrect use of the sofa or if the instructions have not been followed.

NOTE!



When opening the package do not use any sharp or other objects that could damge the surfaces of the product.



Do not lift or drag the sofa from its armrest or any of the cushions. When moving the sofa, lift only from frame.

Warranty terms and conditions

Bellus gives a 2 year EU warranty.

The warranty covers manufacturing and material defects that have occurred during the warranty period. The precondition is that the errors reported within a reasonable time after its observation, or the moment when it can be assumed that the error should have been detected. When a defect is noted, the product must be used with such care to avoid any further damage to the product. The product should be used in such a manner and in a the environment for which it was designed (for example, an upholstered sofa should not be used outdoors).

The warranty period starts from the moment the product is purchased from a Bellus dealer. If the product should be rapired at some point, note that repairing the product will not extend or renew the original warranty period. The warranty is valid only if the product is used as for what it was intended, and that Bellus care instructions have been followed.

The product shall not be seen as faulty if it complies with general Bellus norms and when it corresponds to the shop sample. Assessment of any defect shall be made when the product is placed in a position it would normally be used in and when fully assembled.

Notifying of a claim

If you encounter a fault or an error in the product, you must immediately make a claim about the fault to the shop where the product was

purchased from. The claim must include the description of the problem, photos from near and far that show the problem and it's location and the purchase receipt.

Care instructions

You extend the life of your sofa with regular maintenance and by using the product properly according to instructions.

When cleaning the sofa, it is important to controll the suitability of the substance used for cleaning the product. Before cleaning the whole sofa with any substance it is recommended to try the cleaning product on a small non-visible surface of the sofa.

Below a quick reference for most common cases.



Upholstery fabric should be vacuumed regularly using a furniture nozzle on the vacuumcleaner. Never vacuum without the soft nozzle, as this may damage the fabric and the fiber filling bellow it. If the fabric gets wet, immediately dry it off with a clean damp cloth, patting softly. Do not use any strong cleaning or bleaching agents.



Leather is a natural material where the surface shows traces of life. The surface may show healed scarring, insect bites or differences in grain.

These all emphasize the authenticity of the product and give it a valuable look.

In order for leather to stand time in a nice way, it should be cleaned and cared for regularly. When cleaning, only use products for upholstery leather. Check the cleaning products compatibility to your leather type to avoid any damage to the leather. When dusting off, use a clean damp cloth to clean the surfaces.



New furniture might have a scent that will dissapear within weeks. All Bellus sofas meet the EU Reach requirements and are not harmful to your health in any way.



After opening the package, you have to pat the seat and back cushion into their correct position and form.

At first the new padding may feel abit hard but the padding will soften up after a few months of use.

Ripples and rinkles may arise in all upholstered furniture. This is caused by the movement of the fabric, stretching and the combined effect of wadding. The Products life span is not reduced in any way by stretching and wrinkles. Wrinkles can be a smoothed out by hand.
